PLAYGROUND RULES



Staff must carefully supervise the children and be constantly aware of all their movements.

- 1. Focus your eyes and ears on the children.
- 2. Avoid conversation with other adults: this keeps you from supervising effectively.
- 3. Situate yourselves so that you can see all the children.
- 4. To be ready to help or to move fast in an emergency, never sit with a child in your lap or arms unless that child is hurt.
- 5. Never leave the children unattended. If you must leave, notify the office.
- 6. Report all accidents to the parents in written form, having the parent sign at pick-up. Notify parents immediately, if medical service is needed.

<u>PARENTS</u>, please read and talk with your child about the following playground safety rules. The safety of all children is of upmost importance; therefore, as time goes by, refinements may be made to these rules.

- 7. Students should climb up/down the equipment in a proper manner, using the steps. Jumping from the top, climbing, or hanging on the outside equipment safety rails (not using steps/handrails) is not allowed.
- 8. Go down the slide feet first, while sitting; climbing up the slides is not permitted.
- 9. Only go up the rock wall.
- 10. One child at a time on the ladder.
- 11. Students are not permitted to travel to/from the playground unattended.
- 12. The gates must always remain closed unless entering or leaving the playground.
- 13. Parents must notify staff when dropping off and/or picking up your child from the playground.
- 14. The fence and mulch are for playground safety. Climbing on the fence, hanging items from the fence, and <u>playing with</u> the mulch is NOT ALLOWED.
- 15. Report any unsafe conditions/hazards of the playground or equipment to the Administration.
